- Solar gain from windows

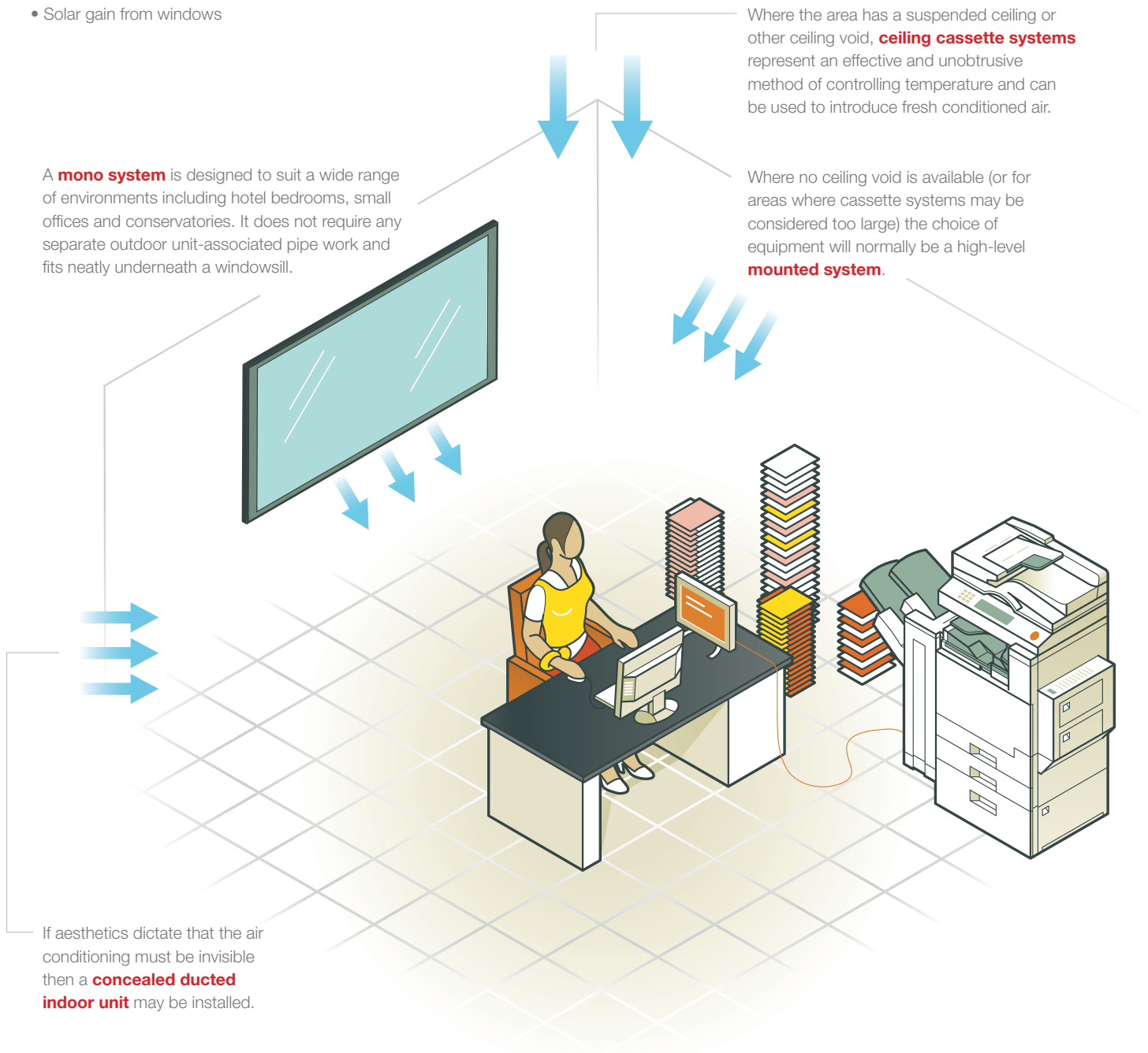
# TOO HOT OR TOO COLD?

A **mono system** is designed to suit a wide range of environments including hotel bedrooms, small offices and conservatories. It does not require any separate outdoor unit-associated pipe work and fits neatly underneath a windowsill.

Where the area has a suspended ceiling or other ceiling void, **ceiling cassette systems** represent an effective and unobtrusive method of controlling temperature and can be used to introduce fresh conditioned air.

Where no ceiling void is available (or for areas where cassette systems may be considered too large) the choice of equipment will normally be a high-level **mounted system**.



If aesthetics dictate that the air conditioning must be invisible then a **concealed ducted indoor unit** may be installed.
